Production down by 5.1% in February 2024

Industry and construction continue to decline

Vienna, 2024-04-10 – The calendar-adjusted production index for industry and construction decreased by 5.1% in February 2024 compared to February of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Compared to January 2024, it increased by 2.7% (seasonally adjusted).

In comparison with the **previous month January 2024**, the seasonally adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production ($\ddot{O}NACE\ 2008\ B-E$) increased by 0.9% in February 2024. Compared to January 2024, the main industrial groupings (MIG) showed the following results: intermediate goods +1.6%, capital goods +1.2%, consumer non-durables $\pm 0.0\%$, energy -3.1%, consumer durables -3.2% (see table 1).

In a **year-on-year comparison**, the calendar adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production index (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) reached 98.1 points in February 2024 and was therefore 5.0% under the result of February 2023. The calendar-adjusted production in construction decreased by 5.9% compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change, the main industrial groupings (MIG) were subject to the following developments: consumer non-durables +3.7%, capital goods –5.0%, intermediate goods –6.6%, energy –8.3%, consumer durables –19.8% (see table 1).
